The MAT degree in Art Education at George Mason University includes all coursework necessary to prepare students for Virginia licensure and meet the Fairfax County Public Schools requirements in PK-12 Art Education. Prospective MAT candidates are required to complete an undergraduate studio art program with an appropriate distribution and equivalent hours for a BFA in studio art at Mason, as well as preparatory art education and general education coursework prior to acceptance into the MAT program.
